- AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to the reduction of mercury in mercury-added lamps

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 27-2101 of the environmental conservation law is 1 Section 1. 2 amended by adding five new subdivisions 30, 31, 32, 33, and 34 to read 3 as follows: 4 30. "MERCURY-ADDED LAMP" MEANS AN ELECTRIC LAMP TO WHICH MERCURY OR 5 MERCURY COMPOUNDS ARE INTENTIONALLY ADDED DURING THE MANUFACTURING PROC-6 ESS, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, COMPACT FLUORESCENT LAMPS, HALO-7 PHOSPHATE STRAIGHT FLUORESCENT LAMPS, AND TRIPHOSPHATE (TRIBAND PHOSP-8 HATES) STRAIGHT FLUORESCENT LAMPS WITH NORMAL OR LONG LIFETIME. 9 31. "PRODUCER OF MERCURY-ADDED LAMPS" MEANS ANY PERSON WHO: 10 (A) MANUFACTURES AND SELLS MERCURY-ADDED LAMPS UNDER ITS OWN BRAND; (B) RESELLS UNDER ITS OWN BRAND EQUIPMENT PRODUCED BY OTHER SUPPLIERS, 11 A RESELLER NOT BEING REGARDED AS THE PRODUCER OF MERCURY-ADDED LAMPS IF 12 BRAND OF THE PRODUCER OF MERCURY-ADDED LAMPS APPEARS ON THE EOUIP-13 THE MENT, AS PROVIDED FOR IN PARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS SUBDIVISION; 14 15 (C) IMPORTS OR EXPORTS ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT ON A PROFESSIONAL BASIS; OR 16 17 (D) SERVES AS THE IMPORTER OR DOMESTIC DISTRIBUTOR OF A MERCURY-ADDED LAMP IF THE BRAND NAME OWNER IS LOCATED OUTSIDE OF THE UNITED STATES. 18 32. "GENERAL PURPOSE LIGHTS" MEANS THE FOLLOWING LAMPS, BULBS, TUBES, 19 20 ELECTRIC DEVICES THAT PROVIDE FUNCTIONAL ILLUMINATION FOR OR OTHER 21 INDOOR RESIDENTIAL, INDOOR COMMERCIAL, AND OUTDOOR USE: COMPACT FLUORES-22 CENT LAMPS UP TO NINE INCHES IN LENGTH AND STRAIGHT FLUORESCENT LAMPS UP 23 TO FIFTY INCHES IN LENGTH WITH A MEDIUM BI-PIN OR MINIATURE BI-PIN BASE,

"LONG LIFETIME" MEANS MORE THAN TWENTY-FOUR THOUSAND HOURS WHEN 9 10 TESTED ON AN ELECTRONIC OR ELECTROMAGNETIC BALLAST, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A T8 INSTANT START BALLAST, A T12 RAPID START BALLAST, OR A 11 12 PROGRAMMED START BALLAST, AND TURNED ON AND OFF EVERY THREE HOURS Т5 13 ("THREE HOUR STARTS"). 14 S 2. Section 27-2107 of the environmental conservation law is amended 15 by adding two new subdivisions 11 and 12 to read as follows: 11. ON AND AFTER JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND THIRTEEN, NO PRODUCER OF 16 17 MERCURY-ADDED LAMPS SHALL SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, OR DISTRIBUTE SUCH LAMPS THAT FAIL TO MEET MERCURY CONTENT STANDARDS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT, 18 19 FOR THE FOLLOWING GENERAL PURPOSE LIGHTS, MERCURY CONTENT SHALL BE AND NO HIGHER THAN: 20 21 (A) FIVE MILLIGRAMS FOR COMPACT FLUORESCENT LAMPS; 22 (B) TEN MILLIGRAMS FOR HALOPHOSPHATE STRAIGHT FLUORESCENT LAMPS; 23 (C) FIVE MILLIGRAMS FOR TRIPHOSPHATE STRAIGHT FLUORESCENT LAMPS WITH A 24 NORMAL LIFETIME; 25 (D) EIGHT MILLIGRAMS FOR TRIPHOSPHATE STRAIGHT FLOURESCENT LAMPS WITH 26 A LONG LIFETIME. 12. ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER THIRTY-FIRST, TWO THOUSAND THIRTEEN, MERCURY 27 28 STANDARDS ESTABLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION SHALL NOT CONTENT 29 APPLY TO SPECIAL PURPOSE LIGHTS. 30 S 3. Section 27-2111 of the environmental conservation law, as amended by chapter 676 of the laws of 2005, is amended to read as follows: 31 32 S 27-2111. Regulations. The department shall promulgate and enforce any regulations necessary 33 34 to implement the provisions of this title. 35 Such regulations shall provide for the proper storage, recycling and 36 disposal of mercury-added consumer products at facilities regulated 37 pursuant to titles seven and nine of this article. 38 SUCH REGULATIONS MAY PROVIDE FOR MERCURY CONTENT STANDARDS FOR MERCU-39 RY-ADDED LAMPS NOT INCONSISTENT WITH SECTION 27-2107 OF THIS TITLE. 40 S 4. Subdivision 1 of section 71-2724 of the environmental conservation law, as added by chapter 145 of the laws of 2004, is amended to 41 42 read as follows: 43 1. Any person who knowingly or intentionally violates any provision of 44 or fails to perform any duty pursuant to title twenty-one of article 45 twenty-seven of this chapter, except subdivision one of section 27-2105 AND SUBDIVISION ELEVEN OF SECTION 27-2107 of this chapter, shall upon 46 47 the first finding of such a violation be liable for a civil penalty not 48 to exceed one hundred dollars. Any person convicted of a second or subsequent violation shall be liable for a civil penalty not to exceed 49 50 five hundred dollars for each violation. 51 S 5. Section 71-2724 of the environmental conservation law is amended 52 by adding a new subdivision 2-a to read as follows: 53 2-A. ANY PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY OR INTENTIONALLY VIOLATES OR FAILS TO 54 PERFORM ANY DUTY IMPOSED BY SUBDIVISION ELEVEN OF SECTION 27-2107 OF CHAPTER OR ANY OF THE PROVISIONS, RULE, OR REGULATION PROMULGATED 55 THIS

56 PURSUANT THERETO SHALL BE PUNISHABLE IN THE CASE OF A FIRST VIOLATION,

1	BY A CIVIL PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED	TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS. IN THE CASE OF A
2	SECOND AND ANY FURTHER VIOLATION,	THE LIABILITY SHALL BE FOR A CIVIL
3	PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-FIVE	THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR EACH VIOLATION.
4	S 6. This act shall take effect	immediately.
