- AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the definitions of aggravated and first degree murder

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Mark's Law".
