- AN ACT to amend the town law, the village law and the not-for-profit corporation law, in relation to qualifications to serve as a volunteer firefighter

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 16 of section 176-b of the town law, as added 2 by chapter 719 of the laws of 1985, is amended to read as follows:

3 16. A person who has been convicted of arson in any degree OR A VIOLATION THAT REQUIRES REGISTRATION UNDER THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION 4 5 AS ESTABLISHED BY ARTICLE SIX-C OF THE CORRECTION LAW, shall not be ACT 6 eligible to be elected or appointed as a volunteer member of a fire The membership of any volunteer member of a fire company shall 7 company. 8 immediately terminate if he is convicted of arson in any degree OR A 9 VIOLATION THAT REQUIRES REGISTRATION UNDER THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION 10 ACT AS ESTABLISHED BY ARTICLE SIX-C OF THE CORRECTION LAW while a member 11 of a fire company.

5 S 3. Subdivision 18 of section 10-1006 of the village law, as added by 6 chapter 719 of the laws of 1985, is amended to read as follows:

7 18. A person who has been convicted of arson in any degree OR A 8 VIOLATION THAT REQUIRES REGISTRATION UNDER THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION 9 ACT AS ESTABLISHED BY ARTICLE SIX-C OF THE CORRECTION LAW, shall not be 10 eligible to be elected or appointed as a volunteer member of a fire company. The membership of any volunteer member of a fire company shall 11 immediately terminate if he is convicted of arson in any degree OR A 12 VIOLATION THAT REQUIRES REGISTRATION UNDER THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION 13 14 ACT AS ESTABLISHED BY ARTICLE SIX-C OF THE CORRECTION LAW while a member 15 of a fire company.

16 S 4. Subdivision 19 of section 10-1006 of the village law, as added by 17 chapter 423 of the laws of 1999, is amended to read as follows:

Upon application by any person for membership in a fire company 19 operating pursuant to this section, the fire chief shall cause the applicant's background to be checked pursuant to section eight hundred 20 21 thirty-seven-o of the executive law for a criminal history involving a 22 conviction for arson AND SEARCH THE INTERNET SUBDIRECTORY MANDATED UNDER 23 ARTICLE SIX-C OF THE CORRECTION LAW FOR A CRIMINAL HISTORY INVOLVING CONVICTION FOR A VIOLATION THAT REQUIRES REGISTRATION UNDER 24 SUCH 25 ARTICLE.

S 5. Subparagraph 4 of paragraph (c) of section 1402 of the not-forprofit corporation law, as added by chapter 719 of the laws of 1985, is amended to read as follows:

29 (4) A person who has been convicted of arson in any degree OR Α VIOLATION THAT REQUIRES REGISTRATION UNDER THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION 30 ACT AS ESTABLISHED BY ARTICLE SIX-C OF THE CORRECTION LAW, shall not be 31 32 eligible to be named in the certificate of incorporation of a fire 33 corporation, or to be elected or appointed as a volunteer member of a fire corporation. The membership of 34 any volunteer member of a fire 35 corporation shall immediately terminate if he OR SHE is convicted of arson in any degree OR A VIOLATION THAT REQUIRES REGISTRATION UNDER THE36 37 SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION ACT AS ESTABLISHED BY ARTICLE SIX-C OF THE CORRECTION LAW while a member of a fire corporation. 38

39 S 6. Subparagraph 5 of paragraph (c) of section 1402 of the not-for-40 profit corporation law, as added by chapter 423 of the laws of 1999, is 41 amended to read as follows:

42 (5) Upon application by any person for membership in a fire corpo-43 ration operating pursuant to this section, the fire chief shall cause 44 the applicant's background to be checked pursuant to section eight hundred thirty-seven-o of the executive law for a criminal history involving a conviction for arson AND SEARCH THE INTERNET SUBDIRECTORY 45 46 SUBDIRECTORY 47 MANDATED UNDER ARTICLE SIX-C OF THE CORRECTION LAW FOR A CRIMINAL HISTO-48 RY INVOLVING CONVICTION FOR A VIOLATION THAT REQUIRES REGISTRATION UNDER 49 SUCH ARTICLE.

50 S 7. This act shall take effect immediately.
