- AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to the management of Atlantic cod

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 13-0339-a of the environmental conservation law, as 1 amended by chapter 146 of the laws of 2007, is amended to read as 2 3 follows: 4 S 13-0339-a. SUCH MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS MAY INCLUDE size limits, catch and 10 possession limits, open and closed seasons, closed areas, restrictions on the manner of taking and landing, requirements for permits and eligi-11 bility therefor, recordkeeping requirements, requirements on the amount 12 and type of fishing effort and gear, and requirements relating to trans-13 14 portation, possession and sale, provided that such regulations are no 15 less restrictive than requirements set forth in this chapter and 16 provided further that such regulations are consistent with the compliance requirements of applicable fishery management plans adopted by the 17 Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission and applicable 18 with 19 provisions of fishery management plans adopted pursuant to the Federal Fishery Conservation and Management Act (16 U.S.C. S 1800 et seq.). 20
