AN ACT to amend the elder law, in relation to authorizing certain county operated NY Connects: Choices for Long Term Care programs to participate in a universal assessment demonstration program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

DIRECTOR, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF HEALTH, SHALL ESTABLISH A UNIFORM ASSESSMENT DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM. THE INITIATIVE IS TO DETERMINE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE UNIFORM THIS ASSESSMENT PROGRAM FUNDED PURSUANT TO CHAPTER FIFTY-THREE OF THE LAWS OF TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN. THE DIRECTOR SHALL SELECT ONE OR MORE COUNTY CHOICES FOR LONG TERM CARE PROVIDERS TO PARTICIPATE ATED NY CONNECTS: BASED ON CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE DIRECTOR. THE DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM SHALL ASSESS WHETHER THE UNIFORM ASSESSMENT TOOL IS EFFECTIVE IN APPROPRIATE LEVEL OF LONG TERM CARE FOR INDIVIDUALS IN NEED MINING THE OF NON-MEDICAL HOME AND COMMUNITY BASED SERVICES ADMINISTERED THE OTHER PROGRAMS AS DETERMINED BY THE DIRECTOR. S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall have become a law.
