Introduced by Sens. ZELDIN, JOHNSON, GRISANTI -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Environmental Conservation

AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to continuing regulations relating to the management of whelks and conchs

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 6 of section 13-0330 of the environmental conservation law, as amended by chapter 143 of the laws of 2007, is amended to read as follows:
- 6. The department may, until December thirty-first, two THIRTEEN, fix by regulation measures for the management of 6 whelk or conch (Busycon spp.), including size limits, catch and 7 possession limits, open and closed seasons, closed areas, restrictions 8 on the manner of taking and landing, requirements for permits and eligi-9 bility therefor, recordkeeping requirements, requirements on the amount and type of fishing effort and gear, and requirements relating to trans-10 portation, possession and sale, provided that such regulations are no 11 less restrictive than requirements set forth in this chapter 12 provided further that such regulations are consistent with the compli-13 ance requirements of applicable fishery management plans adopted by the 14 15 Marine Fisheries Commission and with applicable Atlantic States 16 provisions of fishery management plans adopted pursuant to the Federal 17 Fishery Conservation and Management Act (16 U.S.C. S 1800 et seq.).
- 18 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
