- AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to information contained in the sex offender registry

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 168-q of the correction law, as 2 amended by chapter 532 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as 3 follows:

4 The division shall maintain a subdirectory of level two and three 1. sex offenders. The subdirectory shall include the exact address, address 5 6 of the offender's place of employment and photograph of the sex offender 7 along with the following information, if available: name, physical 8 description, age and distinctive markings. Background information 9 including the sex offender's crime of conviction, modus of operation, 10 type of victim targeted, the name and address of any institution of higher education at which the sex offender is enrolled, attends, 11 is employed or resides and a description of special conditions imposed on 12 13 the sex offender shall also be included. The subdirectory shall have sex offender listings categorized by county and zip code. Such subdirectory 14 15 shall be made available at all times on the internet via the division THE SUBDIRECTORY 16 homepage. THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN SHALL BE THE ZIP CODE FOR BOTH THE OFFENDER'S 17 SEARCHABLE VIA THE INTERNET BY RESIDENCE ADDRESS AND HIS OR HER PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT. Any person may 18 19 apply to the division to receive automated e-mail notifications whenever a new or updated subdirectory registration occurs in a geographic area 20 21 specified by such person. The division shall furnish such service at no

1 charge to such person, who shall request e-mail notification by county 2 and/or zip code on forms developed and provided by the division. E-mail 3 notification is limited to three geographic areas per e-mail account. 4 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 5 have become a law.
