AN ACT to amend the domestic relations law, in relation to adoption records

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 114 of the domestic relations law is amended by adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:
- 5. AN ADOPTIVE PERSON WHO HAS REACHED HIS OR HER MAJORITY MAY HAVE
  ACCESS TO HIS OR HER ORIGINAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE WITHOUT THE NECESSITY OF
  A COURT ORDER UPON PROOF TO THE COURT IN WHICH THE ORDER WAS GRANTED
  THAT THE ADOPTIVE PERSON AND HIS OR HER BIOLOGICAL PARENTS HAVE REGISTERED WITH THE STATE'S ADOPTION REGISTRY AND HAVE CONSENTED TO THE
  RELEASE OF THE IDENTIFYING INFORMATION. IF ONLY ONE BIOLOGICAL PARENT
- 9 EXECUTED THE SURRENDER AGREEMENT OR CONSENTED TO THE ADOPTION, THEN THE 10 REGISTRATION OF THE OTHER BIOLOGICAL PARENT IN SAID REGISTRY SHALL NOT
- 11 BE NECESSARY FOR THE RELEASE OF THE INFORMATION PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDI-
- 12 VISION.
- 13 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
