- AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to creating medicinal guidelines to aid in the administration of prescription drugs to patients with high risks of addiction

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Michael 2 David Israel addiction transition law".

3 S 2. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 3351-a 4 to read as follows:

5 S 3351-A. GUIDELINES. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROMULGATE MEDICAL GUIDE-TITLE TO 6 LINES AND REGULATIONS FOR PERSONS AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS 7 DISTRIBUTE OR DISPENSE SUBSTANCES CONTROLLED UNDER THIS TITLE FOR THE PURPOSE OF HELPING SUCH PERSONS TRANSITION PATIENTS FROM PAIN MANAGEMENT 8 WITH A HIGH RISK OF ADDICTION TO PAIN MANAGEMENT SOLUTIONS 9 SUBSTANCES THAT PRESENT A LOW RISK OF ADDICTION OR DO NOT INVOLVE SUBSTANCES REGU-10 LATED UNDER THIS TITLE. 11

12 S 3. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 13 have become a law, provided, however, that effective immediately, the 14 addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary 15 for the implementation of this act on its effective date are authorized 16 and directed to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
