- AN ACT in relation to authorizing the town of Mamaroneck and the village of Mamaroneck to designate a portion of New York Route 1 as a school zone

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the highway 1 law, the 2 vehicle and traffic law or any other laws to the contrary, the town of 3 Mamaroneck and the village of Mamaroneck are hereby authorized to designate a school speed zone on West Boston Post Road (New York Route 1) with a posted speed limit of 20 miles per hour, effective school days 4 5 between 7 AM and 5 PM, to be located between Winthrop Avenue in the town 6 of Mamaroneck and the entrance of Mamaroneck Town Hall, 740 West Boston 7 Post Road, in the village of Mamaroneck. 8

9 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
