- AN ACT to amend the uniform district court act, in relation to the territorial definition of a commercial claim

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (a) of section 1801-A of the uniform district 2 court act, as amended by chapter 41 of the laws of 2006, is amended to 3 read as follows:

(a) The term "commercial claim" or "commercial claims" as used in this 4 5 shall mean and include any cause of action for money only not in act excess of the maximum amount permitted for a small claim in the small 6 7 claims part of the court, exclusive of interest and costs, provided that 8 subject to the limitations contained in section eighteen hundred nine-A of this article, the claimant is a corporation, partnership or associ-9 ation, which has its principal office in the state of New York and 10 provided that the defendant either resides, or has an office for the 11 transaction of business or a regular employment, within [the] A district 12 13 in the county where the court is located.

14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
