AN ACT to amend the public health law and the social services law, in relation to notification of death of persons receiving public assistance

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 2 4148 to read as follows: 3 S 4148. NOTIFICATION OF DEATH; PERSONS RECEIVING PUBLIC ASSISTANCE. 1. 4 FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE TERM "COMPETENT PERSON ACQUAINTED WITH 5 THE FACTS OF SUCH DEATH" SHALL MEAN: б A. THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR, UNDERTAKER OR PERSON HAVING CHARGE OF THE 7 BODY WHEN DEATH OCCURS WITHOUT MEDICAL ATTENTION; OR 8 THE ATTENDING PHYSICIAN OR HOSPITAL WHEN DEATH OCCURS WITH MEDICAL в. 9 ATTENTION OR IN A HOSPITAL. 10 2. UPON THE DEATH OF ANY PERSON, A COMPETENT PERSON ACQUAINTED WITH OF SUCH DEATH SHALL, WITHIN TWENTY-FOUR HOURS OF SUCH DEATH, 11 FACTS THE12 NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES REGARDING SUCH DEATH. SUCH NOTIFICATION SHALL BE MADE VIA THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES WEBPAGE 13 14 ON THE INTERNET OR BY USE OF A TOLL-FREE TELEPHONE NUMBER ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF SOCIAL SERVICES PURSUANT 15 TO SUBDIVISION (I) OF 16 SECTION SEVENTEEN OF THE SOCIAL SERVICES LAW. SUCH NOTIFICATION SHALL INCLUDE THE NAME, ADDRESS, BIRTH DATE AND SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OF SUCH 17 18 DECEASED PERSON. Subdivision (i) of section 17 of the social services law, as 19 S 2. 20 relettered by section 1 of part K-3 of chapter 57 of the laws of 2007, 21 is relettered subdivision (j) and a new subdivision (i) is added to read 22 as follows:

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(I) ESTABLISH A HOTLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF NOTIFICATION OF DEATH 1 2 REQUIRED BY SECTION FORTY-ONE HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHT OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH 3 LAW. SUCH HOTLINE SHALL PROVIDE ACCESS TO THE DEPARTMENT VIA THE DEPART-MENT WEBPAGE ON THE INTERNET OR BY A TOLL-FREE TELEPHONE NUMBER. 4 ACCESS 5 TO SUCH HOTLINE SHALL BE LIMITED TO PERSONS SET FORTH IN SUBDIVISION ONE SECTION FORTY-ONE HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHT OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW, AND 6 OF 7 SHALL BE ACCESSED ONLY BY MEANS OF A PASSWORD, CODE OR OTHER SECURE 8 METHOD PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT. UPON RECEIPT OF ANY NOTIFICATION OF DEATH, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DETERMINE IF SUCH DECEASED PERSON WAS A 9 10 RECIPIENT OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE AND IMMEDIATELY CEASE THE PAYMENT OF SUCH PUBLIC ASSISTANCE WHEN APPROPRIATE. 11

12 S 3. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 13 have become a law.
