- AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to unlawful manufacture, production or reproduction of a vehicle identification number with intent to defraud

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 170.65 of the penal law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 4 to read as follows:

(4) HE OR SHE, WITH INTENT TO DEFRAUD, KNOWINGLY MANUFACTURES, PRODUCES OR REPRODUCES A VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER, ETCHING, LABEL, STICKER, PLATE, OR OTHER TANGIBLE MEANS OF IDENTIFYING A SPECIFIC MOTOR VEHICLE, WHICH WAS NOT MANUFACTURED, PRODUCED OR REPRODUCED IN ACCORDANCE
WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE UNITED STATES NATIONAL
HIGHWAY SAFETY ADMINISTRATION AND/OR IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS
OF THE STATE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW.

10 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-11 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
