AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system in the city of New York as the "Theodore Roosevelt Memorial Parkway"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Legislative findings. The legislature hereby finds that Theodore Roosevelt, the twenty-sixth President of the United States, was one of our greatest New Yorkers. His dedication to public service spanned local, state and federal government levels as New York City Police Commissioner, Assemblyman, Governor, Assistant Secretary of the Navy, Vice President and President. A native of New York, Teddy or "T.R." as he was called, was a Nobel peace prize winner, war hero, trustbuster, and conservationist. It is the intent of this act to recognize the many contributions of Theodore Roosevelt to our state and country.

- 11 S 2. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 343-z to read 12 as follows:
  - S 343-Z. PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE "THEODORE ROOSEVELT MEMORIAL PARKWAY". ALL THAT PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM KNOWN AS THE GRAND CENTRAL PARKWAY BEGINNING IN THE CITY OF NEW YORK AT THE SOUTHERN END OF THE ROBERT F. KENNEDY BRIDGE AND ENDING AT THE NORTHERN STATE PARKWAY, ALSO KNOWN AS THE "PURPLE HEART WAY", AT THE NASSAU COUNTY LINE IN THE VILLAGE OF LAKE SUCCESS, TOWN OF NORTH HEMPSTEAD, COUNTY OF NASSAU, SHALL BE DESIGNATED AND KNOWN AS THE "THEODORE ROOSEVELT MEMORIAL PARKWAY".
  - S 3. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section two of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designation called for pursuant to section two of this act shall be one of a ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be changed as a result of this act.
  - S 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
