AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to creating a
distinctive plate for members of the United States power squadrons

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new
2 section 404-x to read as follows:
3 S 404-X. DISTINCTIVE PLATES FOR MEMBERS OF THE UNITED STATES POWER
4 SQUADRONS. 1. ANY MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES POWER SQUADRONS RESIDING
5 IN THIS STATE, SHALL, UPON REQUEST, BE ISSUED A LICENSE PLATE BEARING
6 THE WORDS "UNITED STATES POWER SQUADRONS". APPLICATION FOR SUCH LICENSE
7 PLATE SHALL BE FILED WITH THE COMMISSIONER IN SUCH FORM AND DETAIL AS
8 THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PRESCRIBE, AND SHALL BE VERIFIED ANNUALLY BY THE
9 APPLICANT. NO LICENSE PLATE SHALL BE ISSUED TO AN APPLICANT WITHOUT
10 VERIFICATION THAT SUCH APPLICANT IS A MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES POWER
11 SQUADRONS.
12 2. A DISTINCTIVE PLATE ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE ISSUED
13 IN THE SAME MANNER AS SUCH OTHER NUMBER PLATES UPON THE PAYMENT OF THE
14 REGULAR REGISTRATION FEE PRESCRIBED BY SECTION FOUR HUNDRED ONE OF THIS
15 ARTICLE, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT AN ADDITIONAL ANNUAL SERVICE CHARGE OF
16 TWENTY DOLLARS SHALL BE CHARGED FOR SUCH PLATE. SUCH ANNUAL SERVICE
17 CHARGE SHALL BE DEPOSITED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION FOUR
18 HUNDRED FOUR-OO OF THIS ARTICLE TO THE CREDIT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR
19 VEHICLES DISTINCTIVE PLATE DEVELOPMENT FUND ESTABLISHED BY SECTION NINE-
20 TY-FIVE-G OF THE STATE FINANCE LAW AND SHALL BE USED FOR THE PRODUCTION,
21 DESIGN, ADVERTISING AND MARKETING OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE PLATES PURSUANT
22 TO SUCH SECTION NINETY-FIVE-G.
23 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
