AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to aggravated cruelty to animals

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 353-a of the agriculture and markets law, as added by chapter 118 of the laws of 1999, is amended to 3 read as follows:

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- 1. A person is guilty of aggravated cruelty to animals when, with no justifiable purpose, he or she intentionally kills or intentionally causes serious physical injury to a companion animal OR WILDLIFE, AS 7 DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION SIX OF SECTION 11-0103 OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL OTHER THAN INSECTS, with aggravated cruelty. CONSERVATION LAW, purposes of this section, "aggravated cruelty" shall mean conduct which: 9 10 (i) is intended to cause extreme physical pain; or (ii) is done or 11 carried out in an especially depraved or sadistic manner.
- 12 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 13 have become a law.
