AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the crime of assault on a judge

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 120.09 to 2 read as follows:
- 3 S 120.09 ASSAULT ON A JUDGE.
- A PERSON IS GUILTY OF ASSAULT ON A JUDGE WHEN, WITH INTENT TO PREVENT A JUDGE FROM PERFORMING OFFICIAL JUDICIAL DUTIES, HE OR SHE CAUSES SERI-
- 6 OUS PHYSICAL INJURY TO SUCH JUDGE. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION,
- 7 THE TERM JUDGE SHALL MEAN A JUDGE OF A COURT OF RECORD OR A JUSTICE 8 COURT.
- 9 ASSAULT ON A JUDGE IS A CLASS C FELONY.
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day 11 after it shall have become a law.
