AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to assaulting a New York city sanitation worker

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivisions 3 and 11 of section 120.05 of the penal law, as separately amended by chapters 318 and 345 of the laws of 2010, are amended to read as follows:

- 3 With intent to prevent a peace officer, a police officer, regis-5 tered nurse, licensed practical nurse, sanitation enforcement agent, NEW YORK CITY SANITATION WORKER, a firefighter, including a firefighter acting as a paramedic or emergency medical technician administering 7 8 first aid in the course of performance of duty as such firefighter, emergency medical service paramedic or emergency medical service techni-9 cian, or medical or related personnel in a hospital emergency depart-10 ment, a city marshal, a traffic enforcement officer or traffic enforce-11 12 ment agent, from performing a lawful duty, by means including releasing 13 or failing to control an animal under circumstances evincing the actor's 14 intent that the animal obstruct the lawful activity of such peace officer, police officer, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, sanita-15 16 tion enforcement agent, NEW YORK CITY SANITATION WORKER, firefighter, 17 paramedic, technician, city marshal, traffic enforcement officer or traffic enforcement agent, he or she causes physical injury to such 18 19 peace officer, police officer, registered nurse, licensed practical 20 nurse, sanitation enforcement agent, NEW YORK CITY SANITATION WORKER, firefighter, paramedic, technician or medical or related personnel in a 21 22 hospital emergency department, city marshal, traffic enforcement officer 23 or traffic enforcement agent; or
- 24 11. With intent to cause physical injury to a train operator, ticket 25 inspector, conductor, signalperson, bus operator or station agent
