AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to automobile racing facilities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended 2 by adding a new subdivision 20-d to read as follows:

3 20-D. "AUTOMOBILE RACING FACILITY" MEANS ANY CLOSED-COURSE MOTORSPORTS 4 COMPLEX AND ITS ANCILLARY GROUNDS THAT HAS AT LEAST FIFTY THOUSAND FIXED 5 SEATS FOR RACE PATRONS AND HOSTS AT LEAST ONE NASCAR SPRINT CUP SERIES 6 RACE AND AT LEAST TWO OTHER NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED RACING EVENTS EACH 7 CALENDAR YEAR.

8 S 2. The opening paragraph of subdivision 5 of section 106 of the 9 alcoholic beverage control law, as amended by chapter 83 of the laws of 10 1995, is amended to read as follows:

11 No alcoholic beverages shall be sold, offered for sale or given away 12 upon any premises licensed to sell alcoholic beverages at retail for 13 on-premises consumption, EXCEPT AUTOMOBILE RACING FACILITIES, during the 14 following hours:

15 S 3. Section 106 of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended by 16 adding a new subdivision 5-a to read as follows:

17 5-A. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES SHALL BE SOLD, OFFERED FOR SALE OR GIVEN 18 AWAY UPON AN AUTOMOBILE RACING FACILITY LICENSED TO SELL ALCOHOLIC 19 BEVERAGES AT RETAIL FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION BETWEEN FOUR ANTE MERI-20 DIEM AND EIGHT ANTE MERIDIEM.

21 S 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
