AN ACT to amend the civil rights law, in relation to waiving the state's sovereign immunity to claims under the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The civil rights law is amended by adding a new section 16 2 to read as follows:
- S 16. WAIVER OF STATE IMMUNITY; AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990. THE STATE HEREBY WAIVES ITS SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY WITH REGARD TO ALL CLAIMS, ACTIONS AND PROCEEDINGS BROUGHT PURSUANT TO THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990 (P.L. 101-336, AS AMENDED). THE PROVISIONS OF SUCH ACT SHALL APPLY TO THE STATE, AND ANY INSTRUMENTALITY OR POLITICAL
- 8 SUBDIVISION THEREOF.
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 10 have become a law and shall be deemed to have been in full force and 11 effect on and after February 21, 2001.
