AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the reporting of criminal activity on subways

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 14-150 of the administrative code of the city of 1 2 New York is amended by adding a new subdivision d to read as follows: D. 3 THE NEW YORK CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE CITY COUN-4 CIL ANNUALLY A REPORT DETAILING THE TOTAL NUMBER OF CRIMINAL COMPLAINTS 5 ARRESTS, CATEGORIZED BY CLASS OF CRIME, FOR VIOLENT FELONY OFFENSES AND ASSAULT 6 AS DEFINED IN SECTION 70.02 OF THE PENAL LAW, AND RELATED OFFENSES AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY OF THE PENAL LAW, SEX 7 8 OFFENSES AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE ONE HUNDRED THIRTY OF THE PENAL LAW, OF THE PENAL LAW, 9 DISORDERLY CONDUCT AS DEFINED IN SECTION 240.20 HARASSMENT AS DEFINED IN SECTION 240.25 AND 240.26 OF 10 THE PENAL LAW, AGGRAVATED HARASSMENT AS DEFINED IN SECTION 240.30 AND 240.31 OF THE 11 12 PENAL LAW, AND OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC SENSIBILITIES AS DEFINED IN ARTI-CLE TWO HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE OF THE PENAL LAW, WHERE THE CONDUCT OCCURS ON 13 14 SUBWAY LINES AND BUS ROUTES OPERATED BY THE NEW YORK CITY TRANSIT AUTHORITY, SPECIFYING WHERE SUCH CRIMINAL CONDUCT HAS OCCURRED BY POLICE 15 PRECINCT, INCLUDING SPECIFIC SUBWAY LINE, SUBWAY TRANSIT DIVISION, AND 16 17 BUS ROUTE OPERATED BY THE NEW YORK CITY TRANSIT AUTHORITY. SUCH REPORT 18 SHALL CONTAIN A SEPARATE TABULATION FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE AUTHORITY, 19 PASSENGERS AND OTHER NON-EMPLOYEES. SUCH STATISTICS SHALL BE TABULATED 20 BASIS AND ON AN ANNUAL BASIS AND SHALL BE MAINTAINED AND A MONTHLY ON TRANSMITTED IN AN ELECTRONIC FORMAT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF RECORDS 21 AND 22 SERVICES, OR ITS SUCCESSOR AGENCY, AND BE MADE AVAILABLE TO INFORMATION 23 THE PUBLIC ON OR THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF RECORDS AND INFORMATION 24 SERVICES' WEBSITE, OR ITS SUCCESSOR'S WEBSITE. SUCH STATISTICS SHALL BE 25 FIRST MADE AVAILABLE ON SUCH WEBSITE NINETY DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE SUBDIVISION AND SHALL BE UPDATED ON AT LEAST A MONTHLY 26 OF THIS DATE 27 BASIS THEREAFTER.

28 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
