AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to exempting veterans eightyfive years of age and older from the obligation to pay New York state income tax

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 601 of the tax law is amended by adding a new 2 subsection (d-1) to read as follows:
- 3 (D-1) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTIONS (A), (B), (C) AND 4 (D) OF THIS SECTION, FOR TAXABLE YEARS BEGINNING AFTER DECEMBER THIRTY-5 FIRST, TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN, THE INCOME OF ANY RESIDENT INDIVIDUAL EIGHT-6 Y-FIVE YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER WHO QUALIFIES AS A VETERAN UNDER THE 7 PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION THREE OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED FIFTY OF THE 8 EXECUTIVE LAW SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM TAXATION UNDER THIS ARTICLE REGARD-9 LESS OF WHETHER SUCH INCOME IS SUBJECT TO FEDERAL INCOME TAXATION.
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to all 11 taxable years commencing on or after January 1, 2012.
