AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to public librarian certificate fee

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 279 of the education law, as amended by chapter 458 of the laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

S 279. Fees. 1. A fee of [five] FIFTY dollars shall be paid for each public librarian's certificate [or school librarian's certificate] issued under THIS part [two of this article] AS DEFINED IN REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE COMMISSIONER.
2. A FEE OF SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS SHALL BE PAID FOR EACH PUBLIC LIBRARIAN'S CONDITIONAL OR TEMPORARY CERTIFICATE ISSUED UNDER THIS PART AS DEFINED IN REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE COMMISSIONER.

S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
