AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to the hunting of deer and bear in Cortland county; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Item (f) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the environmental conservation law, as amended by section 11 of chap-3 ter 483 of the laws of 2010, is amended to read as follows: Deer, first Monday 4 (f) Southern tier, Pistol, shotqun, 5 central and Western after November 15 crossbow, through first Tuesday muzzle loading firearm 6 region, except those 7 counties or portions after December 7 or long bow only 8 thereof listed in 9 item (i) OR (J) 10 of this paragraph S 2. Item (f) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of 11 12 the environmental conservation law, as amended by section 12 of chapter 483 of the laws of 2010, is amended to read as follows: 13 (f) Southern tier, 14 Deer and bear, first Pistol, shotgun, 15 central and Western Monday after November crossbow, muzzle loading firearm 16 region, except those 15 through first 17 counties or portions Tuesday after or long bow only 18 thereof listed in December 7 item (i) OR (J) 19

- S 5. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that:
- (a) the amendments to item (f) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the environmental conservation law made by section one of this act shall be subject to the expiration and reversion of such paragraph pursuant to section 13 of chapter 600 of the laws of 1993, as amended, when upon such date the provisions of section two of this act shall take effect;
- (b) the amendments to item (f) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the environmental conservation law made by section two of this act shall be subject to the expiration and reversion of such paragraph pursuant to section 17 of chapter 483 of the laws of 2010, as amended;
- (c) section three of this act shall take effect on the same date as the reversion of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the environmental conservation law, as provided in section 13 of chapter 600 of the laws of 1993, as amended, or as provided in section 17 of chapter 483 of the laws of 2010, as amended, whichever is later;
- (d) the amendments to item (j) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the environmental conservation law made by section four of this act shall survive the expiration and reversion of such paragraph as provided in section 13 of chapter 600 of the laws of 1993, as amended, and as provided in section 17 of chapter 483 of the laws of 2010, as amended; and
- (e) nothing contained in this act shall be construed so as to extend the provisions of this act beyond January 1, 2014, when upon such date this act shall expire and the provisions contained in this act shall be deemed repealed.
