AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law and the education law, in relation to electronic monitoring equipment on school buses in the city of New York

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 375 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 21-j to read as follows:

3 21-J. EVERY NEW SCHOOL BUS USED TO TRANSPORT SEVEN OR MORE CHILDREN IN 4 A CITY WITH A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH A 5 SCHOOL BUS ELECTRONIC MONITORING SYSTEM ON AND AFTER SEPTEMBER FIRST, THOUSAND FOURTEEN, AND EVERY SCHOOL BUS IN SERVICE FOR SUCH TRANSб TWO 7 PORT SHALL BE SO EQUIPPED NOT LATER THAN SEPTEMBER FIRST, TWO THOUSAND 8 SEVENTEEN, PURSUANT TO RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE COMMIS-9 SIONER AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMISSIONERS OF TRANSPORTATION AND FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION, THE TERM "SCHOOL BUS 10 EDUCATION. ELECTRONIC MONITORING SYSTEM" MEANS ONE OR MORE ELECTRONIC DEVICES CAPA-11 BLE OF RECORDING THE SPEED, SOUND, CONDUCT AND MOVEMENT OF PERSONS WITH-12 IN THE DRIVER AND PASSENGER COMPARTMENTS OF THE BUS. 13 SUCH SYSTEM MAY INCLUDE ONE OR MORE DEVICES DESIGNED TO SIMULATE THE APPEARANCE OF 14 ALSO AN OPERABLE VIDEO CAMERA OR OTHER DEVICE. 15

16 S 2. The education law is amended by adding a new section 3624-a to 17 read as follows:

18 S 3624-A. SCHOOL BUS ELECTRONIC MONITORING SYSTEMS. THE COMMISSIONER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE 19 COMMIS-MOTOR VEHICLES, SHALL PROMULGATE REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE 20 SIONER OF EQUIPPING, PLACEMENT, INSTALLATION, AND USE OF 21 SCHOOL BUS ELECTRONIC 22 SYSTEMS IN SCHOOL BUSES AS REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION MONITORING 23 TWENTY-ONE-J OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE OF THE VEHICLE AND 24 THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE TERM "SCHOOL BUS TRAFFIC LAW. FOR

EXPLANATION--Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets
[] is old law to be omitted.

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ELECTRONIC MONITORING SYSTEM" MEANS ONE OR MORE ELECTRONIC DEVICES CAPA-BLE OF RECORDING THE SPEED, SOUND, CONDUCT AND MOVEMENT OF PERSONS WITH-IN THE DRIVER AND PASSENGER COMPARTMENTS OF THE BUS. SUCH SYSTEM MAY ALSO INCLUDE ONE OR MORE DEVICES DESIGNED TO SIMULATE THE APPEARANCE OF AN OPERABLE VIDEO CAMERA OR OTHER DEVICE. SUCH REGULATIONS SHALL APPLY TO THE CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK AND SHALL REQUIRE OR BE CONSISTENT WITH THE FOLLOWING:

8 1. ALL SCHOOL BUSES SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH SCHOOL BUS ELECTRONIC MONI-9 TORING SYSTEMS, THAT WILL ACCOMPLISH THE PURPOSE AND INTENT OF THIS 10 SECTION IN THE MOST EFFECTIVE AND LEAST COSTLY MANNER, AS FOLLOWS: ALL 11 NEW SCHOOL BUSES SHALL BE SO EQUIPPED ON AND AFTER SEPTEMBER FIRST, TWO 12 THOUSAND FOURTEEN, AND ALL SCHOOL BUSES IN SERVICE FOR SUCH TRANSPORT 13 SHALL BE SO EQUIPPED NOT LATER THAN SEPTEMBER FIRST, TWO THOUSAND SEVEN-14 TEEN.

ON AND AFTER SEPTEMBER FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TWELVE, THE DISTRICT 15 2. 16 SHALL CONDUCT A DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM INVOLVING NO LESS THAN FIVE 17 PERCENT OF EXISTING SCHOOL BUSES WHICH SHALL BE RETROFITTED IN A DEMON-18 STRATION PROJECT CONDUCTED FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING THE MOST 19 EFFECTIVE AND LEAST COSTLY MEANS OF ACCOMPLISHING THE PURPOSE AND INTENT 20 THIS SECTION. INSOFAR AS PRACTICABLE, BUSES USED FOR THE DEMON-OF STRATION PROGRAM SHALL BE SPREAD OVER CONTRACTORS IN THE SAME 21 RATIO AS BUSES OPERATED BY SUCH CONTRACTORS HAVE OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF BUSES 22 USED BY THE DISTRICT FOR THE SYSTEM. THE SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL REPORT 23 24 ON THE RESULTS OF THE PLAN BY SEPTEMBER FIRST, TWO THOUSAND THIRTEEN TO 25 THE COMMISSIONER, THE GOVERNOR AND THE LEGISLATURE.

26 3. SCHOOL BUS ELECTRONIC MONITORING SYSTEMS ON SCHOOL BUSES SHALL BE 27 USED ONLY AS AN AID TO MONITOR ON-BOARD ACTIVITIES.

4. RECORDS CREATED BY THE SCHOOL BUS ELECTRONIC MONITORING SYSTEMS
SHALL BE STORED IN A SECURE LOCATION FOR A PERIOD OF TIME DESIGNATED BY
THE COMMISSIONER, BUT NOT FOR A PERIOD LESS THAN NINETY DAYS, UNLESS
THERE IS A REPORT OF AN INCIDENT, IN WHICH CASE THE RECORDS PERTAINING
TO SUCH INCIDENT SHALL BE KEPT FOR A PERIOD TO BE DETERMINED BY THE
COMMISSIONER.

5. SUCH RECORDS SHALL BE REVIEWED BY DESIGNATED PERSONNEL PURSUANT TO AN INCIDENT REPORT AND ON A REGULAR BASIS USING RANDOM SELECTION CRITE-RIA, IN ORDER TO ENSURE PROPER DRIVER AND PUPIL CONDUCT.

37 6. ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SECTION OR OF SUBDIVISION TWENTY-ONE-J 38 SECTION THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW OF 39 NOTWITHSTANDING, THE COMMISSIONER IS AUTHORIZED TO WAIVE ANY PROVISION 40 THE SCHOOL BUS ELECTRONIC MONITORING SYSTEM REQUIREMENT ESTABLISHED OF PURSUANT TO SUCH SUBDIVISION WITH RESPECT TO THE DISTRICT IF THE COMMIS-41 SIONER DETERMINES THAT THE REQUIREMENT IS IMPRACTICABLE, OR THAT IT 42 IS 43 FINANCIALLY OR PHYSICALLY BURDENSOME AND INEFFECTIVE WITH RESPECT TO THE GOAL, OR IF THE DISTRICT PROPOSES AND THE COMMISSIONER ACCEPTS AN ALTER-44 45 NATE MEANS OF ACHIEVING THE SAME GOAL.

7. ALL PUPILS AND ALL SCHOOL BUS DRIVERS SHALL BE NOTIFIED BY MEANS OF 46 47 SIGNAGE AND BY ANY OTHER MEANS PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSIONER THAT THEY 48 ARE SUBJECT TO BEING VIDEOTAPED ON A SCHOOL BUS AT ANY TIME. SUCH 49 NOTIFICATION SHALL BE MADE BY THE SCHOOL TO THE PARENTS OF PUPILS. 50 DRIVERS, PARENTS AND PUPILS SHALL BE ADVISED WHAT DRIVER CONDUCT AND 51 WHAT PUPIL CONDUCT IS PROHIBITED BY THE STATE AND BY THE DISTRICT AND THAT SUCH CONDUCT WILL RESULT IN SPECIFIED DISCIPLINARY CONSEQUENCES AS 52 53 DEFINED IN THE ESTABLISHED DISCIPLINE POLICY.

54 8. NOT LESS THAN TWICE EACH SCHOOL YEAR NOTIFICATIONS REGARDING ELEC-55 TRONIC MONITORING MUST OCCUR, ADDRESSING THE PURPOSE AND USE OF ELEC-56 TRONIC EQUIPMENT AND THE NEED FOR PERSONAL AWARENESS OF SAFETY ISSUES. 1 THE USE OF NEWSLETTERS, PUPIL HANDOUTS, AND NOTICES POSTED WITHIN THE 2 BUS MAY CONSTITUTE MEANS OF FULFILLING THIS REQUIREMENT.

9. RECORDS UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL REMAIN CONFIDENTIAL AND SHALL BE4 USED ONLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DISCIPLINARY AND ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS.

5 S 3. Paragraph c of subdivision 2 of section 3623-a of the education 6 law, as amended by chapter 453 of the laws of 2005, is amended to read 7 as follows:

8 c. The purchase of equipment deemed a proper school district expense, 9 including: (i) the purchase of two-way radios to be used on old and new 10 school buses, (ii) the purchase of stop-arms, to be used on old and new school buses, (iii) the purchase and installation of seat safety belts 11 on school buses in accordance with the provisions of section thirty-six hundred thirty-five-a of this article, (iv) the purchase of school bus 12 13 back up beepers, (v) the purchase of school bus front crossing arms, 14 (vi) the purchase of school bus safety sensor devices, (vii) THE 15 PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF SCHOOL BUS ELECTRONIC MONITORING SYSTEMS ON 16 SCHOOL BUSES AND BACKUP AND STORAGE SYSTEMS REQUIRED TO MAINTAIN RECORDS 17 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION THIRTY-SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-18 19 FOUR-A OF THIS PART, (VIII) the purchase and installation of exterior reflective marking on school buses, [(viii)] (IX) the purchase of auto-20 21 matic engine fire extinguishing systems for school buses used to trans-22 port students who use wheelchairs or other assistive mobility devices, and [(ix)] (X) the purchase of other equipment as prescribed in the regulations of the commissioner; and 23 24

25 S 4. This act shall take effect on the one hundred thirtieth day after 26 it shall have become a law.
