THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subdivision 2 of section 1193 of the vehi-1 2 cle and traffic law is amended by adding a new subparagraph 4 to read as 3 follows:
- (4) IN NO EVENT SHALL A NEW LICENSE BE ISSUED OR A FORMER LICENSE BE RESTORED TO A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF SUBDIVI-TWO OR THREE, OR BOTH SUBDIVISION TWO AND SUBDIVISION THREE, OF SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-TWO OF THIS ARTICLE WHERE PHYSICAL SUCH CONVICTED PERSON RESULTED FROM SUCH OFFENSE WHICH INJURY RESULTED IN THE TRANSPORT OF SUCH PERSON BY AMBULANCE OR OTHER MEDICAL TRANSPORT TO A HOSPITAL, UNLESS ALL BILLS FOR SUCH TRANSPORT AND ANY 11 OTHER PRE-HOSPITAL MEDICAL EXPENSES HAVE BEEN PAID PRIOR TO THE12 SUCH PERSON APPLIES FOR A NEW LICENSE OR FOR RESTORATION OF THE FORMER 13 LICENSE AND UNLESS PROOF OF THE PAYMENT OF SUCH BILLS IS SUBMITTED
