AN ACT to amend the general municipal law and the education law, in relation to the information technology procurement savings act of 2012; provides local governments and school districts more contract flexibility; and provides for purchasing services

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "the information technology procurement savings act of 2012".

- S 2. Section 103 of the general municipal law is amended by adding a new subdivision 16 to read as follows:
- 5 16. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION 6 AND IN ADDITION TO THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION THREE OF THIS 7 SECTION ONE HUNDRED FOUR OF THIS ARTICLE, ANY OFFICER, BOARD OR AGENCY OF A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR OF ANY DISTRICT THEREIN AUTHORIZED 9 MAKE PURCHASES OF MATERIALS, EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES MAY MAKE SUCH 10 PURCHASES AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY SUCH POLITICAL SUBDIVISION 11 DISTRICT THEREIN THROUGH THE USE OF A CONTRACT LET BY ANY OTHER STATE OR 12 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION IF SUCH CONTRACT WAS LET IN ACCORDANCE WITH 13 COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS THAT ARE CONSISTENT WITH THIS SECTION WITH THE INTENT OF EXTENDING ITS USE TO CERTAIN OTHER GOVERNMENTAL 14 ENTITIES. 1 PERMITTED UNDER THE PROCUREMENT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES OF THE POLITICAL 2 SUBDIVISION OR DISTRICT, ADOPTED PURSUANT TO SECTION ONE HUNDRED FOUR-B 3 OF THIS ARTICLE.

- S 3. The general municipal law is amended by adding a new section 109-c to read as follows:
- S 109-C. PURCHASE OF SERVICES. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF 7 SECTION ONE HUNDRED THREE OF THIS ARTICLE OR ANY OTHER GENERAL, SPECIAL 8 OR LOCAL LAW, ANY OFFICER, BOARD OR AGENCY OF A VILLAGE, TOWN OR COUNTY AUTHORIZED TO MAKE PURCHASES THROUGH THE LOCAL SCHOOL OR BOARD OF 9 10 COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES (BOCES) DISTRICT SUBJECT TO SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS AS MAY BE ESTABLISHED FROM TIME TO TIME PURSUANT TO 11 12 SECTION ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE OF THE STATE FINANCE LAW OR THROUGH GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 1555 OF THE FEDERAL 13 14 ACQUISITION STREAMLINING ACT OF 1994. ALL PURCHASES SHALL BE SUBJECT AUDIT AND INSPECTION BY THE VILLAGE, TOWN OR COUNTY. NO OFFICER, BOARD 15 OR AGENCY OF A VILLAGE, TOWN OR COUNTY SHALL MAKE A PURCHASE THROUGH 16 SUCH SCHOOL OR BOCES DISTRICT WHEN BIDS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED FOR SUCH 17 PURCHASE BY SUCH OFFICER, BOARD OR AGENCY, UNLESS SUCH PURCHASE MAY BE 18 19 MADE UPON THE SAME TERMS, CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS AT A LOWER PRICE THROUGH SUCH SCHOOL OR BOCES DISTRICT. 20
 - S 4. The education law is amended by adding a new article 25 to read as follows:

ARTICLE 25 SHARED CONTRACTS

SECTION 1210. SHARED TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES.

- S 1210. SHARED TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF ANY GENERAL, SPECIAL OR LOCAL LAW TO THE CONTRARY, ANY LOCAL SCHOOL OR BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES DISTRICT SHALL BE AUTHORIZED TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS TO SHARE PROCUREMENT CONTRACTS FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES, AS REFERENCED IN SCHOOL DISTRICT CAPITAL EQUIPMENT AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION FORTY-THREE OF SECTION SIXTEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX OF THE PUBLIC AUTHORITIES LAW, OFFERED BY THE DEPARTMENT WITH ANY OFFICER, BOARD OR AGENCY OF A VILLAGE, TOWN OR COUNTY.
- 36 S 5. This act shall take effect immediately, and shall apply to 37 procurement contracts entered into on or after such effective date.
