AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to the designation of the "Saratoga County Veterans' Memorial Highway"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 342-iii 2 to read as follows:
 - S 342-III. PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE "SARATOGA COUNTY VETERANS' MEMORIAL HIGHWAY". THAT PORTION OF STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 32 IN WATERFORD NORTH TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH ROUTE 423 IN THE TOWN OF STILLWATER THEN CONTINUING BOTH: (A) NORTH ALONG ROUTE 32 PAST THE SARATOGA NATIONAL CEMETERY AND THE SARATOGA BATTLEFIELD TO WILBUR ROAD IN THE TOWN OF SARATOGA; AND (B) EAST ALONG ROUTE 423 IN THE TOWN OF STILLWATER TO ROUTE 9P NORTH IN THE TOWN OF SARATOGA AND ENDING AT THE ROUTE 9P BRIDGE OVER FISH CREEK IN THE TOWN OF SARATOGA SHALL BE DESIGNATED AS THE "SARATOGA COUNTY VETERANS' MEMORIAL HIGHWAY".
 - S 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of a ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be changed as a result of this act.
