AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to providing a multiple event caterer's permit

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 98 of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended 2 by adding a new subdivision 1-a to read as follows:

3 1-A. THE LIQUOR AUTHORITY IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO CATERERS PERMIT EFFECTIVE FOR A ONE YEAR PERIOD WHICH SHALL AUTHORIZE THE SERVICE 5 OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT MULTIPLE FUNCTIONS, OCCASIONS OR EVENTS IN A 6 HOTEL, RESTAURANT, CLUB, BALLROOM, OR OTHER PREMISES. CATERERS WHO HAVE 7 ISSUED SUCH A PERMIT SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE THE LIQUOR 8 AUTHORITY WITH INFORMATION, AS SPECIFIED BY THE LIQUOR AUTHORITY, REGARDING EACH FUNCTION OR EVENT AND ITS LOCATION AT LEAST FIVE BUSINESS 9 10 PRIOR TO THEFUNCTION OR EVENT. THE PERMIT SHALL AUTHORIZE THE DAYS SERVICE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE HOURS, FIXED BY OR PURSUANT TO 11 12 SUBDIVISION FIVE OF SECTION ONE HUNDRED SIX OF THIS CHAPTER, BEVERAGES MAY LAWFULLY BE SOLD OR SERVED UPON PREMISES 13 WHICH ALCOHOLIC LICENSED TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT RETAIL FOR ON-PREMISES 14 15 $_{
m THE}$ COMMUNITY IN WHICH IS LOCATED THE PREMISES IN WHICH SUCH FUNCTION OR EVENT IS HELD. A PERMIT SHALL ONLY BE ISSUED TO AN ON-PREM-16 THE FEE THEREFORE SHALL BE TWO 17 LIQUOR, WINE OR BEER LICENSEE. HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS. SUCH A PERMIT AND THE EXERCISE OF THE PRIVILEGE 18 THEREBY MAY BE SUBJECTED TO SUCH RULES BY THE LIQUOR AUTHORITY 19 GRANTED 20 AS IT DEEMS NECESSARY.

21 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 22 it shall have become a law.
