AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to authorizing angling by a single individual with up to three lines in freshwater

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subparagraph 2 of paragraph b of subdivision 12 of section 11-0103 of the environmental conservation law, as amended by chapter 215 of the laws of 1995, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (2) one person may operate not more than two lines, with or without 5 rod, EXCEPT THAT ONE PERSON MAY OPERATE UP TO THREE LINES IN FRESHWATER; 6 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
