AN ACT to amend the navigation law, in relation to requiring certain persons to obtain a boating safety certificate prior to operating water craft

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 49-a of the navigation law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 5-a to read as follows:
 - 5-A. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY OF THE PROVISIONS CONTAINED WITHIN SUBDIVISION TWO OR FOUR OF THIS SECTION SHALL ALSO BE REQUIRED TO SUCCESSFULLY OBTAIN A BOATING SAFETY CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO HIM OR HER BY THE COMMISSIONER, THE UNITED STATES POWER SQUADRONS OR THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD AUXILIARY PRIOR TO BEING ELIGIBLE TO OPERATE A VESSEL.
 - S 2. Subdivision 9 of section 49-b of the navigation law is amended by adding a new paragraph (d) to read as follows:
 - (D) A PERSON WHO IS SUBJECT TO A SUSPENSION OF OPERATING PRIVILEGES PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL ALSO BE REQUIRED TO SUCCESSFULLY OBTAIN A BOATING SAFETY CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO HIM OR HER BY THE COMMISSIONER, THE UNITED STATES POWER SQUADRONS OR THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD AUXILIARY PRIOR TO BEING ELIGIBLE TO OPERATE A VESSEL.
 - S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
