AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to allowing the use of rifles for hunting in certain portions of Ontario county

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

25 date the provisions of section two of this act shall take effect; the
26 amendments to item (i) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section
27 11-0907 of the environmental conservation law made by section two of
28 this act shall be subject to the expiration and reversion of such item
29 pursuant to section 13 of chapter 600 of the laws of 1993, as amended,
30 when upon such date the provisions of section three of this act shall
31 take effect; provided further, that the amendments to item (i) of para-
32 graph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the environmental conser-
33 vation law made by section three of this act shall be subject to the
34 expiration and reversion of such item pursuant to section 17 of chapter
35 483 of the laws of 2010, as amended, when upon such date the provisions
36 of section four of this act shall take effect.
