AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to the disqualification of school bus drivers for certain offenses involving children

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Subdivision 4 of section 509-cc of the vehicle and traffic law, as added by chapter 675 of the laws of 1985, paragraph amended by chapter 93 of the laws of 2006, paragraph (b) as amended by chapter 360 of the laws of 1986, and paragraph (c) as amended by chapter 405 of the laws of 2010, is amended to read as follows:
