- AN ACT to amend the public housing law, in relation to modifying the composition of the membership of the Buffalo municipal housing authority

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 404 of the public housing law, as amended by chap-2 ter 576 of the laws of 1993, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 S 404. Buffalo Municipal Housing Authority. 1. The Buffalo Municipal 4 Housing Authority is hereby constituted and declared to be a body corpo-5 rate and politic with all the powers, rights and duties set forth in 6 article five of the former state housing law.
- 7 GOVERNING BOARD OF THE AUTHORITY SHALL BE COMPRISED OF SEVEN 2. THEMEMBERS, WITH TWO MEMBERS ELECTED BY TENANTS, TWO MEMBERS 8 APPOINTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL AND THREE MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR OF BUFFALO, 9 10 ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE DESIGNATED BY THE MAYOR AS CHAIRMAN REMOVABLE AT 11 HIS OR HER PLEASURE. Notwithstanding any inconsistent provision of law, 12 any member of such authority appointed or reappointed by THE COMMON 13 COUNCIL OR the mayor of Buffalo shall be subject to confirmation by a majority vote of the common council of such city. 14
- 3. THE TERM OF OFFICE OF EACH MEMBER SHALL BE FIVE 15 MAYOR YEARS. THE16 WITH THE COMMISSIONER A CERTIFICATE OF APPOINTMENT OF THE SHALL FILE 17 CHAIRMAN AND OF EACH MEMBER. ANY MEMBER OTHER THAN THE CHAIRMAN MAY ΒE 18 REMOVED BY THE MAYOR FOR CAUSE AFTER A PUBLIC HEARING. A VACANCY IN THE 19 OFFICE OF A MEMBER OTHER THAN THE CHAIRMAN OCCURRING OTHERWISE ΒY THAN TERM SHALL BE FILLED FOR THE UNEXPIRED TERM; PROVIDED, 20 EXPIRATION OF

3 4. THE CHAIRMAN AND THE MEMBERS OF THE AUTHORITY OTHER THAN THE 4 TENANT MEMBERS SHALL RECEIVE A SALARY, THE AMOUNT OF WHICH SHALL BE 5 FIXED BY LOCAL LAW. THE TWO TENANT MEMBERS SHALL RECEIVE A MONTHLY 6 STIPEND IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS.

7 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
