AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to requiring police officers to notify family members in person of a relative's death in certain circumstances

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Valeria's 2 law".
- 3 S 2. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new section 4 603-c to read as follows:
- S 603-C. ACCIDENTS; POLICE TO NOTIFY IN PERSON. 1. IN EACH MOTOR VEHI-6 CLE ACCIDENT OR ANY OTHER EVENT OR INCIDENT IN WHICH ANY PERSON IS 7 KILLED, WHO WAS NOT IN VIOLATION OF ANY LAW, RULES, REGULATIONS, PROCE-8 DURES OR SUMMONS, THE POLICE OFFICER, AGENCY OR INDIVIDUAL WHO, IN THE 9 REGULAR COURSE OF DUTY, INVESTIGATES SUCH ACCIDENT, EVENT OR INCIDENT 10 SHALL USE REASONABLE EFFORTS TO IDENTIFY AND NOTIFY IN PERSON, A MEMBER 11 OF THE PERSON'S FAMILY OR HOUSEHOLD OF THE FATALITY AS SOON AS PRACTICA-12 BLE AFTER SUCH ACCIDENT, EVENT OR INCIDENT.
- 2. SUCH NOTIFICATION SHALL INDICATE THAT THE PERSON WAS KILLED, THE LOCATION OF THE ACCIDENT, EVENT OR INCIDENT AND THE LOCATION OF THE
- 15 PERSON'S BODY OR REMAINS.
- 16 S 3. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 17 have become a law.
