AN ACT to amend the civil practice law and rules, in relation to enacting the "patient privacy protection act"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as 2 the "patient privacy protection act".

3 S 2. Section 3102 of the civil practice law and rules is amended by 4 adding a new subdivision (c-1) to read as follows:

5 (C-1) EX-PARTE INTERVIEWS. IN ANY ACTION INVOLVING PERSONAL INJURY, 6 MEDICAL, DENTAL, OR PODIATRIC MALPRACTICE OR WRONGFUL DEATH, NO PARTY OR 7 ANYONE ACTING ON BEHALF OF A PARTY MAY EITHER DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY CONDUCT EX-PARTE INTERVIEWS WITH THE TREATING PHYSICIANS OR OTHER HEALTH 8 9 CARE PROVIDERS OF ANY OTHER PARTY. NOTHING IN THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL 10 PROHIBIT AN ATTORNEY OR THE AGENT OR EMPLOYEE OF AN ATTORNEY WHO REPRES-THE PATIENT, THE ESTATE OF THE PATIENT, OR THE NATURAL OR DULY 11 ENTS APPOINTED GUARDIAN OF THE PATIENT WHOSE CONDITION IS AT 12 ISSUE IN THE ACTION FROM CONDUCTING EX-PARTE CONVERSATIONS WITH A TREATING PHYSICIAN 13 OR OTHER HEALTH CARE PROVIDER OF THE PATIENT. 14

15 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to all 16 actions involving personal injury, medical, dental or podiatric malprac-17 tice or wrongful death that are currently pending or are filed on or 18 after such date.
