AN ACT to amend the state law, in relation to the September eleventh national remembrance flag

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The closing paragraph of section 70 of the state law is amended to read as follows:

State flag. [The] EXCEPT ON SEPTEMBER ELEVENTH OF EACH YEAR, THE state flag is hereby declared to be blue, charged with the arms of the state in the colors as described in the blazon of this section. ON SEPTEMBER ELEVENTH OF EACH YEAR, THE STATE FLAG IS HEREBY DECLARED TO BE THE NATIONAL REMEMBRANCE FLAG.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
