AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to tickets purchased for use on the Long Island Rail Road

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The public authorities law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1266-j to read as follows:

- 1266-J. LONG ISLAND RAIL ROAD; REIMBURSEMENT. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, FOR ANY TICKET PURCHASED FOR USE ON ISLAND RAIL ROAD, THE AUTHORITY SHALL REIMBURSE ONE HUNDRED PERCENT OF THE PURCHASE PRICE OF ANY UNUSED LONG ISLAND RAIL ROAD TICKET TO BEARER OF SUCH TICKET, PROVIDED THAT SUCH TICKET IS RETURNED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF PURCHASE. THE AUTHORITY IS PROHIBITED FROM ASSESS-ING ANY SURCHARGE OR PROCESSING FEE FOR THE RETURN OF ANY SUCH UNUSED TICKET PURCHASED FOR USE ON THE LONG ISLAND RAIL ROAD.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 12 have become a law.
