AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to establishing a registry for persons convicted of violating "Buster's Law"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new section 352 to read as follows:

S 352. ANIMAL CRUELTY REGISTER. 1. ANY PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE OR THREE HUNDRED 5 FIFTY-THREE-A OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL REGISTER WITH THE DIVISION OF CRIMI-6 NAL JUSTICE SERVICES. SUCH REGISTRATION SHALL BE MADE IN A MANNER 7 FORM TO BE DETERMINED BY THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES, AND SHALL INCLUDE, AT A MINIMUM, THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF 8 SUCH REGISTRANT. 9 DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES SHALL MAINTAIN REGISTRATION 10 INFORMATION RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION IN A REGISTRY. SUCH REGIS-11 TRY SHALL BE IN PRINT AND IN ELECTRONIC FORM AND SHALL BE AVAILABLE LAW ENFORCEMENT ENTITIES, DISTRICT ATTORNEYS, DULY INCORPORATED 12 13 HUMANE SOCIETIES, SOCIETIES FOR THE PREVENTION OF CRUELTY TO 14 DOG OR CAT PROTECTIVE ASSOCIATIONS, ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICERS, BREEDERS OF ANIMALS AND PET STORES DOING BUSINESS 15 IN THIS STATE. ANY PERSON 16 REQUIRED TO REGISTER PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL REGISTER ANNUALLY, EACH TIME SUCH PERSON MOVES TO A NEW ADDRESS AND SHALL CONTINUE TO 17 REGISTER UNTIL SUCH PERSON RECEIVES A COURT ORDER ORDERING 18 SUCH REGIS-19 TRATION TO CEASE. NO SUCH ORDER SHALL BE ISSUED UNTIL SUCH PERSON FIRST 20 DEMONSTRATES TO THE COURT THAT HE OR SHE HAS UNDERGONE PSYCHIATRIC

ABILITY TO OWN AND PROPERLY CARE FOR AN ANIMAL IN A HUMANE MANNER. ANY PERSON REQUIRED TO REGISTER PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL NOT OWN A COMPANION ANIMAL OR HAVE EMPLOYMENT AT AN ANIMAL SHELTER, POUND, PET STORE, ZOO OR OTHER BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT WHERE COMPANION ANIMALS ARE 5 PRESENT. ANY PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF SECTION THREE 6 HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE OR THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE-A OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL, 7 IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY OR TERM OF IMPRISONMENT AUTHORIZED BY 8 LAW, BE SUBJECT TO A MANDATORY ANNUAL SURCHARGE OF FIFTY DOLLARS WHICH 9 SHALL BE USED TO PAY FOR COSTS AND EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH ESTABLISHING 10 AND MAINTAINING THE REGISTRY REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION.

- 2. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY TO ALL MUNICIPALITIES, INCLUDING CITIES HAVING A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE, AND SHALL SUPERSEDE ANY LOCAL LAW, RULE, REGULATION, CODE OR ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ESTABLISHMENT, IMPLEMENTATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF AN ANIMAL CRUELTY OR ABUSER REGISTRY.
- 16 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 17 have become a law.
