AVELLA, ADAMS, ADDABBO, CARLUCCI, DILAN, DUANE, ESPAILLAT, HASSELL-THOMPSON, HUNTLEY, KLEIN, KRUEGER, KRUGER, MONTGOM-ERY, OPPENHEIMER, PERKINS, RIVERA, SAMPSON, SAVINO, SERRANO, SQUADRON, STAVISKY -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Environmental Conservation -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee
- AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to prohibiting the use of hydraulic fracturing and the disposal and/or processing of any fluid which was used in a hydraulic fracturing process

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph b of subdivision 1 of section 23-0501 of the 2 environmental conservation law is amended by adding a new subparagraph 4 3 to read as follows:

4 (4) "HYDRAULIC FRACTURING" SHALL MEAN FRACTURING OF ROCK BY MAN-MADE 5 FLUID-DRIVEN FRACTURING TECHNIQUES FOR THE PURPOSE OF STIMULATING 6 NATURAL GAS OR OIL WELL PRODUCTION.

7 S 2. Section 23-0305 of the environmental conservation law is amended 8 by adding a new subdivision 15 to read as follows:

9 15. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT ISSUE A PERMIT FOR THE DRILLING OR OPERA-10 TION OF ANY WELL PROPOSING TO USE HYDRAULIC FRACTURING OR HYDRAULIC 11 FRACTURING FLUIDS FOR THE EXTRACTION OF GAS AND/OR OIL.

12 S 3. Subdivision 3 of section 23-0501 of the environmental conserva-13 tion law is renumbered subdivision 4 and a new subdivision 3 is added to 14 read as follows:

15 3. A. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT ISSUE A PERMIT FOR THE DRILLING OR 16 OPERATION OF ANY WELL PROPOSING TO USE HYDRAULIC FRACTURING OR HYDRAULIC 17 FRACTURING FLUIDS FOR THE EXTRACTION OF GAS AND/OR OIL.

[] is old law to be omitted.

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4 S 4. The environmental conservation law is amended by adding a new 5 section 17-0513 to read as follows:

6 S 17-0513. PROHIBITION ON ACCEPTANCE, DISPOSAL AND/OR PROCESSING OF ANY 7 FLUID USED IN A HYDRAULIC FRACTURING PROCESS.

8 1. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF LAW, RULE OR REGULATION TO THE CONTRARY, THE ACCEPTANCE, DISPOSAL AND/OR PROCESSING OF ANY DRILLING 9 FLUIDS OR DRILL CUTTINGS IN THIS STATE, WHEN SUCH DRILLING FLUIDS OR 10 DRILL CUTTINGS HAVE BEEN USED IN A HYDRAULIC FRACTURING PROCESS, IS 11 12 PROHIBITED.

2. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING TERMS SHALL MEAN:

14 "DRILLING FLUIDS" SHALL MEAN DRILLING MUD, CHEMICAL ADDITIVES (A) CONTAINED IN OR ADDED TO DRILLING FLUIDS DURING THE HYDRAULIC FRACTURING 15 DRILLING PROCESS, FLOW BACK WATER THAT RETURNS TO THE SURFACE AFTER THE 16 17 HYDRAULIC FRACTURING PROCESS, OR ANY OTHER RESIDUAL LIQUIDS INVOLVED IN 18 DRILLING.

19 (B) "DRILL CUTTINGS" SHALL MEAN SOLID PRODUCTS REMOVED FROM THE WELL BORE DURING AN OIL OR GAS WELL DRILLING OPERATION. 20

"HYDRAULIC FRACTURING" SHALL MEAN THE FRACTURING OF ROCK BY 21 (C) 22 MAN-MADE FLUID-DRIVEN FRACTURING TECHNIQUES FOR THE PURPOSE OF STIMULAT-23 ING NATURAL GAS OR OIL WELL PRODUCTION.

24 S 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
