THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 103 of the abandoned property law is amended by adding a new subdivision (h) to read as follows: 2
- (H) "RESIDUALS" MEANS PAYMENTS, PURSUANT TO LAW OR A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT, OF ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR DOMESTIC AND 5 FOREIGN USES OF RECORDED MATERIALS.
 - S 2. Section 501 of the abandoned property law is amended by adding a new subdivision 6 to read as follows:
 - 6. A RESIDUALS PAYMENT PLAN, AND THE ACCOUNTS AND MONIES THEREIN, ESTABLISHED BY A LABOR UNION WHICH RECEIVES FOR DISTRIBUTION RESIDUALS BEHALF OF EMPLOYEES WORKING UNDER COLLECTIVE-BARGAINING AGREEMENTS,

- SHALL NOT BE DEEMED ABANDONED PROPERTY IF THE PLAN ALLOWS A PARTICIPANT, 11
- ENTITLED TO A DISTRIBUTION UNDER THE PLAN, TO BE REIMBURSED UPON THE 12
- MAKING OF A VALID CLAIM TO THE LABOR UNION FOR PAYMENT. 13
