AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the definitions of aggravated and first degree murder

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph a of subdivision 1 of section 125.26 of the penal 1 2 law is amended by adding a new subparagraph (ii-a) to read as follows: (II-A) THE INTENDED VICTIM WAS A FIREFIGHTER, VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER, RGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN, AMBULANCE DRIVER, PARAMEDIC, PHYSICIAN OR 3 4 EMERGENCY 5 NURSE INVOLVED IN A FIRST RESPONSE TEAM, OR ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL WHO, IN 6 THE COURSE OF OFFICIAL DUTIES, PERFORMS EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACTIVITIES 7 ENGAGED IN SUCH ACTIVITIES AT THE TIME OF KILLING AND THE AND WAS 8 DEFENDANT KNEW OR REASONABLY SHOULD HAVE KNOWN THAT THE INTENDED VICTIM 9 WAS SUCH UNIFORMED FIREFIGHTER, VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER, EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN, AMBULANCE DRIVER, PARAMEDIC, PHYSICIAN OR NURSE; OR 10 S 2.Paragraph a of subdivision 1 of section 125.27 of the penal law is 11 12 amended by adding a new subparagraph (ii-a) to read as follows: THE INTENDED VICTIM WAS A FIREFIGHTER, VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER, 13 (II-A) 14 EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN, AMBULANCE DRIVER, PARAMEDIC, PHYSICIAN OR NURSE INVOLVED IN A FIRST RESPONSE TEAM, OR ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL WHO, IN 15 THE COURSE OF OFFICIAL DUTIES, PERFORMS EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACTIVITIES 16 17 AND WAS ENGAGED IN SUCH ACTIVITIES AT THETIME OF KILLING AND THE DEFENDANT KNEW OR REASONABLY SHOULD HAVE KNOWN THAT THE INTENDED VICTIM 18 19 WAS SUCH UNIFORMED FIREFIGHTER, VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER, EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN, AMBULANCE DRIVER, PARAMEDIC, PHYSICIAN OR NURSE; OR 20 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately. 21
