AN ACT directing the education department to issue certain state aid to the Central Islip union free school district for certain capital construction projects

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. All the acts done and proceedings heretofore had and taken
2 or caused to be had and taken by the Central Islip Union Free School
3 District and by all its officers or agents relating to or in connection
4 with projects 0002-006, 0003-008, 0005-007, 0006-005, 0007-006, 0008-007
5 and 0004-005, and all acts incidental thereto, upon submission to the
6 commissioner of education of the plans and specifications of such
7 projects on or before June 30, 2011, in such form as such commissioner
8 shall require and following review and approval of such projects by such
9 commissioner pursuant to article 9 of the education law, shall be deemed
10 to be legalized, validated, ratified and confirmed, notwithstanding any
11 failure to comply with the approval and filing provisions of the educa-
12 tion law or any other law or any other statutory authority, rule or
13 regulation, in relation to any omission, error, defect, irregularity or
14 illegality in such proceedings had and taken.

15 S 2. The education department is hereby directed to consider the final
16 building cost reports and specifications submitted for such projects on
17 or before June 30, 2011, to have been submitted in a timely manner, and
18 to review such plans and specifications pursuant to article 9 of the
19 education law, and, if appropriate, to establish approved costs for such
20 projects. The approved costs of the aforementioned projects shall be
21 deemed to be valid and proper obligations of the Central Islip Union
22 Free School District, and provided further that any amount due and paya-

1 ble to the Central Islip Union Free School District for school years
2 prior to the 2011--2012 school year as a result of this act shall be
3 paid pursuant to the provisions of paragraph c of subdivision 5 of
4 section 3604 of the education law.

5 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be deemed to
6 have been in full force and effect on and after June 30, 2006.
