AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to excluding substitute teachers from the limits imposed on unemployment insurance benefits available during vacation periods for professional employees of educational institutions

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 10 of section 590 of the labor law is amended 2 by adding a new paragraph (d) to read as follows:
- (D) THE FOREGOING PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL NOT APPLY IF THE CLAIMANT WAS EMPLOYED IN AN INSTRUCTIONAL CAPACITY ON A SUBSTITUTE OR PER DIEM BASIS AND ANY SUCH CLAIMANT SHALL NOT BE DENIED BENEFITS
- 6 UNDER THIS SECTION SOLELY BY REASON OF THIS SUBDIVISION.
- 7 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
