AN ACT to amend the general city law, in relation to requiring notice of public work projects to residents in certain cities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The general city law is amended by adding a new section 2 18-e to read as follows:

3 S 18-E. NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION, REPAIRS, PUBLIC WORK. ANY CITY WITH A 4 POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE SHALL, WITHIN THREE DAYS OF ANY 5 CONSTRUCTION PROJECT, REPAIR WORK PROJECT OR OTHER PUBLIC WORK PROJECT, 6 NOTIFY RESIDENTS WITHIN A HALF MILE RADIUS OF THE WORK SITE WHERE SUCH 7 PROJECT WILL BE PERFORMED OF SUCH PROJECT. SUCH NOTICE SHALL BE MADE 8 WITH SUFFICIENT SIGNAGE TO READILY NOTIFY SUCH RESIDENTS. ANY 9 CONSTRUCTION PROJECT, REPAIR WORK PROJECT OR OTHER PUBLIC WORK PROJECT 10 BE PERFORMED WHICH A CITY ANTICIPATES WILL BE LESS THAN FORTY-EIGHT TO HOURS IN DURATION SHALL NOT BE SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF 11 THIS SECTION. 12

13 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 14 have become a law.
