- AN ACT to amend the elder law, in relation to authorizing certain county operated NY Connects: Choices for Long Term Care programs to participate in a universal assessment demonstration program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 203 of the elder law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 11 to read as follows:

3 THE DIRECTOR, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF HEALTH, 11. 4 SHALL ESTABLISH A UNIFORM ASSESSMENT DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM. THE PURPOSE 5 INITIATIVE IS TO DETERMINE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE UNIFORM OF THIS б ASSESSMENT PROGRAM FUNDED PURSUANT TO CHAPTER FIFTY-THREE OF THE LAWS OF 7 TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN. THE DIRECTOR SHALL SELECT ONE OR MORE COUNTY OPER-8 CHOICES FOR LONG TERM CARE PROVIDERS TO PARTICIPATE ATED NY CONNECTS: BASED ON CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE DIRECTOR. THE DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM 9 10 SHALL ASSESS WHETHER THE UNIFORM ASSESSMENT TOOL IS EFFECTIVE IN DETER-APPROPRIATE LEVEL OF LONG TERM CARE FOR INDIVIDUALS IN NEED 11 MINING THE 12 OF NON-MEDICAL HOME AND COMMUNITY BASED SERVICES ADMINISTERED ΒY THE OTHER PROGRAMS AS DETERMINED BY THE DIRECTOR.
