AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to allowing the use of rifles for hunting in the county of Madison; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon the expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Item (i) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907
2 of the environmental conservation law, as amended by section 12 of chap-
3 ter 483 of the laws of 2010, is amended to read as follows:

12 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately, provided that the amend-
13 ments to item (i) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of
14 the environmental conservation law made by section one of this act shall
15 take effect on the same date as the reversion of such paragraph pursuant
16 to section 13 of chapter 600 of the laws of 1993, as amended; and
17 provided, further, that the amendments to item (i) of paragraph a of
18 subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the environmental conservation law
19 made by section one of this act shall be subject to the expiration and
20 reversion of such paragraph pursuant to section 17 of chapter 483 of the
21 laws of 2010, as amended, when upon such date the provisions of section
22 two of this act shall take effect; and provided, further, that this act
23 shall expire and be deemed repealed two years after its effective date.
