AN ACT to repeal certain provisions of the public authorities law relating to certain authorities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Intentionally omitted.

3 S 2. Title 1 of article 7 of the public authorities law is REPEALED.
4 S 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any
5 existing records, property, rights, titles and interest and all obli-
6 gations and liabilities of the Amsterdam parking authority shall vest in
7 and be possessed by the city of Amsterdam and its successors or assigns.
8 S 4. Title 1-A of article 7 of the public authorities law is REPEALED.
9 S 4-a. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any
10 existing real property shall pass to the village in which it is located,
11 and if outside the limits of any village, to the town in which located.
12 All other property of the Monroe regional parking authority shall be
13 equally divided among the town of Monroe and the villages of Monroe and
14 Harriman and their successors or assigns.

44 date the remainder of this act, but shall be confined in its operation
45 to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part thereof directly
46 involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been
47 rendered.

48 S 34. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall
