- AN ACT to repeal certain provisions of the general municipal law relating to urban renewal agencies; to repeal certain provisions of the general municipal law relating to industrial development agencies; to repeal certain provisions of the public authorities law relating to certain authorities; to transfer any books, records and remaining rights of any dissolved authority to an identifiable location; and to amend the general municipal law, in relation to the termination of industrial development agencies
