AN ACT to amend the parks, recreation and historic preservation law, in relation to draft management plan submission dates

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 41.09 of the parks, recreation and historic preservation law, as added by chapter 595 of the laws of 2007, is amended to read as follows:
- The draft management plan shall be submitted to the commissioner for approval [within four years of the effective date of this BY DECEMBER THIRTY-FIRST, TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN. Prior to submitting the 7 plan to the commissioner, the legislative representative body of the city of Buffalo must approve the plan. The legislative body of the city 8 of Buffalo, at its discretion and in the interest of expediting the 9 local approval process, shall hold two public meetings at any time 10 during the local approval process. The commissioner may approve the 11 plan, may return the plan to the commission with recommendations for 12 13 approval, or may reject the plan. A copy of the approved plan shall be provided to the governor, the temporary president of the senate and the 14 15 speaker of the assembly.
- 16 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately provided, however, that 17 the amendments to subdivision 2 of section 41.09 of the parks, recre-18 ation and historic preservation law made by section one of this act 19 shall not affect the repeal of such article and shall be deemed repealed 20 therewith.
